VOLUNTEERS NEEDED: All Volunteers must register to help before Recital Day! Only official volunteers, with a name badge, will be allowed in the dressing rooms. We will have a Check-in/Check-fout desk in the hall before the dressing room. Our commitment is to keep your dancer safe, focused and always accounted for. Young Dancers in the opening that are also performing in the second half of the show, may be picked up after opening to sit with their parents until intermission. Volunteers must commit to a FULL show and will receive a free show ticket for volunteering (Volunteers do not need a ticket for backstage during their volunteer time). We will also have a volunteer assigned to the boys' dressing room. After the boys are dressed and ready for their number, they can go into the big dressing room to watch the show on the live TV feed that will be set up in that room. Thanks!

Ticket Prices - Adults \$18, Seniors \$15, Students \$12, Preschool FREE (please email info@tjdance.com to reserve a free preschool ticket). Only prepaid tickets will be reserved.

The same number of tickets bought for 1 show can be purchased for another show at half price (use promo code "50OFF" at checkout on the additional show).

Raffle and Volunteer tickets also need to be pre-reserved, please email info@tjdance.com to do so.

If there are any tickets remaining on the day of the show, they will be available online for an additional \$1.

DRESS REHEARSALS:

Dress rehearsal is scheduled. It moves fast. Please be on time. Dancers will run through their dance on stage as if it were recital day. Be sure and grab your shoes the last week of classes, so you have them with you for rehearsal. There are no dance classes scheduled for rehearsal week (unless set up by teacher). Dress Rehearsal means "show" practice, so please be in tights, costume, make up and have your correct shoes. There is no "Opening" practice at Dress Rehearsal. There is "Finale" practice at 7:30 on Dress Rehearsal day.

RECITAL:

Arrive 30 minutes before the show starts in costume, accessories, tights, make up and with your dance shoes! "I Like to Move it, Move it" opens each show. **Dancers only need to be in the opening of the show they have other dances in.** "I Like to Move it, Move it" dancers should wear anything with animal print or jungle themed. Dancers check in at the school entrance to the dressing room. No parents in dressing rooms except volunteers. Dancers are not allowed in the theater during recital performances except for dancers in the opening that don't dance on stage again until after intermission. Parents may pick those dancers up after opening so they can watch the first half of the show with you. Dancers need returned to dressing room before the end of intermission. Always be sure your dancer has checked in or out of the changing room so we can keep track of ALL of our dancers!

DRESS REHEARSAL & RECITAL GUIDE

- Hair must be up and away from the face (unless prearranged with your teacher).
- Wear STAGE MAKEUP (bold eyes, blush & lipstick). Stage makeup is worn by all performers. Faces without makeup appear washed out with show lighting. Jewelry should be minimal unless it is part of your costume.
- Dancers should arrive in tights. Please, no underwear showing under tights.
- TAP SHOES MUST HAVE ELASTIC - NO TIES - for the younger dancers.
- NO GUM!!! NO GUM!!! NO GUM!!!
- NO CHANGING IN THE BATHROOMS!
- ❖ Girls will change in the big band room.
- ❖ Boys will change in a band practice room.
 - Dancers will be released from the dressing room in their last costume.

OPENING: The opening number for all shows is "I Like to Move it, Move it".

Costume - dancers should wear any combination of animal prints or jungle theme clothing. Wear soft shoes, sock, or bare feet. All "young dancers," participate in welcoming our guests.

FINALE: The Finale is "Queen Medley". Please try to participate in **all** shows to thank our audiences.

Costume – any "Rock Star" attire. Please include a bandana in your costume to bring it all together. It can be on your head, arm, leg, neck (your choice).

PARKING - VERY IMPORTANT ...DO NOT PARK IN THE FIRE LANE! Fire lanes are marked with a RED curb. Also, please keep the theater aisles clear. Park anywhere in Cedarcrest parking lot.

VIDEOS/DVDs: (Order Form Enclosed) Professional videographer Bill Norton will capture the magic of recital day on DVD. We encourage everyone to support Bill's hard work by purchasing a DVD of the entire show. Your dancer will watch it for years!!!

Recital night video cameras and phones must only be used at the back of the theater and for recording your dancer only.

No dance classes at studio rehearsal week - unless prearranged with teacher.
